1. Annunciation
(Angel Gabriel announced Mary will be mother of Jesus)
2. Visitation (of Mary to her cousin Elizabeth)
3. Nativity (Jesus is born in Bethlehem)
4. Presentation of Jesus in the Temple
5. Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple

THE MYSTERIES OF LIGHT

(Sometimes called Luminous Mysteries)

(Prayed on Thursdays; new mysteries given to us by St. John Paul II)

1. Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan
2. Manifestation of Jesus at the Wedding at Cana
3. Proclamation of the Kingdom of God
4. Transfiguration of Jesus
5. Institution of the Eucharist

SORROWFUL MYSTERIES

(Prayed on Tuesdays & Fridays; usually prayed during Season of Lent)

1. Agony in the Garden
2. Scourging at the Pillar
3. Crowning with Thorns
4. Carrying of the Cross
5. Crucifixion (Jesus died on the Cross)

GLORIOUS MYSTERIES

(Prayed on Wednesdays & Sundays; usually prayed during Season of Easter)

1. Resurrection (Jesus rose from the dead)
2. Ascension of Jesus into Heaven
3. Descent of Holy Spirit
4. Assumption of Mary (body and soul into heaven)
5. Coronation of the Blessed Virgin Mary as Queen
